One of the key functions of any new state to the Union is to provide for a republican form of government as required by the U.S. Constitution Article IV, Section 4 known as the Guarantee Clause, "a republican form of government".

In order to be admitted into the Union on an equal footing with the other States in all respects whatever New California State Constitution shall always be republican in form and shall not be repugnant to the Constitution of the United States or the principles of the Declaration of Independence.

Effective July 1, 2020 New California State will begin the process to provide a platform for the formation of political parties. While New California State cannot and will not support a political party or candidate(s) we understand our responsibility to provide the necessary constitutional guarantees necessary to create the formation of a "republican form of government".

U.S. Constitution, Article IV, Section 4.

The United States **shall guarantee to every state in this union a republican form of government**, and shall protect each of them against invasion; and on application of the legislature, or of the executive (when the legislature cannot be convened) against domestic violence.
